# Introduction to the app & disclaimer

The App can be used on compatible Android and iOS devices.


All country-specific guidelines are fully developed, owned, and managed by the individual country. This includes any additional content such as intervention tools, audit tools, etc.

Upon the App's launch, the in-country App Champion is responsible for managing the country content, which includes uploading the newest version of the country guidelines and additional resources.

Any international resources available are fully owned by the respective organisations, e.g. WHO and CDC and these are embedded in the App as live links to these third-party websites, which auto-update when new updates are available.

The App has been designed to minimise the need for internet access. Once the app is downloaded, all country-specific guidance is available offline. Where information such as international guidance/resources is on an external site, e.g., WHO, company websites, etc., an internet connection will be needed. The prescribing companion website is only available online.


### **Getting started**

## Features at a glance

Before we begin with how to access the toolkits and resources, let us take you through the main features so you can get the most from the app.



# Quick menu (and downloading additional toolkits)

Click the quick menu button from any app page to access the resources, called 'Toolkits'. Any toolkits that have already been downloaded to the app will be displayed here.



Tap the download button to browse and download available country toolkits.

From the quick menu, you can also access Contact Us details, About Us information, frequently asked questions (FAQs) and view the disclaimer again.

#### **Quick search**

Hit the magnifying glass icon to use the quick search function. Just start typing a search term and the app will return matching results for the toolkit selected.

Tip! You can use the quick search box to quickly return results for a specific disease area.



#### Return to homepage

Tap the home icon from any resource within a toolkit to return back to that toolkit's home page.









#### **Useful utilities**

You can access several useful utilities from the page of any resource.



Tap the download button to browse and download available country toolkits.


#### International AMS and IPC resources

It can be navigated as follows:



#### **Accessing country toolkits**
