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FOREWORD



Ensuring medicines security for poor, vulnerable, and hard-to-reach communities is a priority of the Government of Sierra Leone. This remains a key driving force behind the Free Health Care Initiative currently in place principally for pregnant women, lactating mothers, and children under-five years old. However, meeting the pharmaceutical demands of the population poses a challenge to all countries especially low-income countries, which have several competing priorities. It is for these reasons that the use of the World Health Organization's guidelines for the selection of Essential Medicines for public health sector provision becomes very critical for the management of the overall health sector budget.

Whilst the public health needs and cost-effectiveness of these health products are very important factors that influenced the selection process, close attention was also paid to the safety and efficacy of the medicines.

The approach of linking the revision of the Essential Medicines List to the revision of the treatment schedules for the National Basic Health Care Packages is an innovative one. We have also taken into consideration health data from the major health facilities in the country and the utilization of laboratory data on the susceptibility trends to the available antimicrobial agents. The approach will ensure a strong link between priority health needs and the Essential Medicines List.

The year 2021 edition of the Essential Medicines List also contains the categorization of medicines according to their indications and healthcare levels of use. This is to promote rational medicines use and improved patient safety.

It is hoped that the efforts of all stakeholders in ensuring medicines security for our population are achieved.

PREFACE

Essential medicines as defined by WHO are those medicines that satisfy the priority health needs of the population. The national Essential Medicines List (EML) is used to guide the importation and distribution, prescription, and dispensing of medicines in a country. The main users of the Essential Medicines List are the Medicines Control Authority for import control and managers of the public pharmaceutical supply chain management system. The national EML also informs clinicians on medicines available in the public health sector medicines supply chain.

For the national Essential Medicines List to fully serve the intended purposes, it should be revised every three years to accommodate new developments in the international market and the changing public health demands. However, medicines for the management of emerging and re-emerging diseases will be addressed promptly when the need arises and in exceptional cases, application to obtain non-listed items could be considered by the Ministry of Health And Sanitation, on the advice of the Directorate of Pharmaceutical Services

Another purpose of revising the national EML is to remove or re-classify products based on safety information generated locally or from other credible sources like the WHO. This latest edition, which is a revision of the year 2016 Essential Medicines List, categorizes/classifies medicines by health care level of use.
